

Crystalaire Community Association Emergency Pool Reopening Rules

The following Pool Use Rules are intended to make the Crystalaire Community Pool accessible to the membership while promoting good hygiene and proper social distancing. The risk of infection associated with COVID-19 is an unknown and, while the Association is taking all government-mandated precautions to minimize the risk, as in any public place, there is no way for the risk to be completely eliminated. Thus, THE USE OF THE ASSOCIATION POOL IS AT YOUR OWN RISK! Also, the Association's ability to keep its facilities open and to mitigate the risk related to COVID-19 is dependent upon everyone working together with social distancing and doing their part to keep everyone as safe as possible.

Pool Rules

1. Anyone using the pool is required to adhere to all the rules contained herein, as well as other posted rules that do not conflict with these rules.
2. A person is not allowed to access or remain at the pool area if he/she is sick, or has a fever or has a confirmed case of COVID-19.
3. Any person visiting the pool area should wash his/her hands or use hand sanitizer regularly.
4. Persons over 2 years old must wear a face mask when traveling through common pool areas (except while in the water), where it may not be possible to maintain physical distancing.
5. Access to the pool area is restricted to residents and their household members only. Guests are not permitted to use the Association pool area at this time.
6. Capacity of the pool shall be restricted to the guidelines set by the State of California, County of Orange, or City of Huntington Beach, whichever is more restrictive.
7. Capacity of the spa is limited to three (3) persons from the same household at a time. The time in the spa should be limited to 15 minutes when others are waiting.
8. The pool hours will remain the same, Sunday-Thursday 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM and Friday-Saturday 6:00 AM to 11:00 PM.
9. Residents are required to respect and follow the requests of any Association agents, including security, relating to when the facility is open or closed, as well as any requests pertaining to proper hygiene or social distancing.
10. Each resident accessing the pool area is required to bring either disposable sanitary wipes or similar cleaning materials to use on any surfaces in the pool area that the resident intends to come into contact with (e.g., to disinfect the door handle before entry). Residents are strongly encouraged to wipe down equipment and/or furnishings both before and after each use as a courtesy to neighbors.
11. Residents shall maintain the minimum safe distance as currently required by the CDC between themselves and any other resident or group. Residents should be respectful of the sentiments of neighbors relating to social distancing.
12. Use of the restrooms is restricted to one (1) person at a time, or a maximum of three (3) persons from the same household.
